Minimum Requirements & Point System

Leadership (Based on originality of ideas, outstanding activities)	40%
Participation in National and Department Programs (Based on Auxiliary's participation in programs)	40%
Personal Participation (Based on Your attendance at Department and District meetings and trainings, presiding over Local meetings, schools of instructions held, etc.)	20%

Requirements:

- Auxiliary must achieve 90% in membership and 100% reporting in all programs by date of judging.
- Must meet all requirements according to the Department Standing Rules and National Bylaws.
